IFSCA Banking Handbook - Opening of SNRR account with AD Banks in India

- 1.Please refer para 6.a.ii of Module 2 (BIFC) of the IFSCA Banking Handbook Conduct of Business (COB) directions v 5.0.
- 2. The contents of the abovementioned para shall be replaced by the following with immediate effect:
- "An IBU may open an INR account, in the form of a Special Non-Resident Rupee Account (SNRRA), with an AD Bank in India to defray its administrative expenses in compliance with the directions of the Reserve Bank of India in this regard."
- 3. IBUs are directed to ensure compliance to the directions this circular.
